WARNING

Motor racing is dangerous and you are entering and participating entirely at your own risk. In consideration of ADELAIDE MOTORSPORT PARK (“the Organiser”) accepting my entry for the event I acknowledge that:

1. The organiser does not warrant the skill, abilities or experience of any other drivers who may be using Adelaide Motorsport Park during the Event. The Organiser does not warrant that other drivers will obey racing rules or drive safely.
2. Driving in such circumstances and motor sport generally is inherently dangerous and that by participating in the Event I will be exposed to risk of injury to myself and the risk of loss or damage to any property in my care and control, and even the risk of injury that may cause my death or physical and/or mental incapacity.
3. Because of my participation in the Event, I may not be covered under any insurance policy that I may have in respect of my life or physical and mental condition. Also, the vehicle I will drive may not be covered by insurance.

I AGREE THAT:

1. I participate in this event at my own risk and that I accept full responsibility for my actions and omissions in any way related to the Event
2. I shall not make any claim against the Organiser, officials, and car owner, or any other driver in respect of any loss, damage or injury to myself or any property in my care and control that arises out of or is in any way relating to my participation in the event.
3. I will indemnify the Organiser and officials in respect of any claim (including legal costs on a party/party basis) made by any person against the Organiser and officials in any way relating to my participation in the Event.

ENTRY TO ADELAIDE MOTORSPORT PARK

- Entry to AMP for competition vehicles will be through the Gate B, Pit Entry gate, not Main Gate.

- Drop Nomination Form into Blair Athol Auto Parts, now located at Adelaide Motorsport Park, 173 Supply Road Waterloo Corner with payment during business hours (9.00am to 5.00pm), or

- Compulsory Personal Accident Insurance application to be completed at track

ENTRY PRICES

Pit Admission (Infield Area of speedway track)

- Competitors \$60.00 (Includes personal accident insurance and car entry with driver)
- Crew \$25.00
- Infield Spectators \$25.00

General Admission (Spectator Area)

- Adults \$15.00
- Pensioners \$15.00

STARTING TIMES

- Competitor Gate opens at 11.00am
- Spectator Gate opens at 12.00 noon
- Drivers Briefing at 13.45pm
- Competition commences at 2.00pm

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- No alcohol or glass to be brought into the Adelaide Motorsport Park complex
- Children under 16 not permitted in Pit Area
- No alcohol permitted in the Pit Area
- All persons in the Pit Area must have closed in footwear
- Full compliance and agreement with "Conditions of Entry" policy available at adelaidemotorsportpark.com

BURN OUT REGULATIONS

REQUIREMENTS

- All Drivers are to complete Nomination Form and sign the Indemnity Acknowledgement before entering the Pit Area
 - Any false information on the Entry Form may result in the Driver being banned from future events
- All Drivers must present a current Drivers Licence (Provisional or Full Licence)
- All Drivers and Passengers must wear long sleeved shirts, long trousers and covered footwear
 - No thongs, sandals, shorts and T shirts allowed
 - No nylon clothing to be worn
- It is mandatory that seat belts are correctly fastened by the Driver and any Passenger during competition
- Helmets must be worn by both the Driver and any Passenger

- The maximum speed of vehicles within the Adelaide Motorsport Park complex and infield is 15 km/hr
- Burn Outs must cease and the vehicle leave the burn out pad immediately on the direction of the Official

VEHICLE SAFETY CHECK

- No loose items to be left in vehicle
- All doors must have secure locking mechanism
- Throttle linkages must have effective return spring
- Vehicles should not have any fuel, oil or fluid leaks; radiator overflow bottle is highly recommended
- The fuel tank, if not by original car manufacturer, is to be of a professional construction standard or fuel cell type and securely mounted
- Battery must be securely mounted
- Brakes must be in good working order
- Scatter shields must be fitted to all modified vehicles with manual transmissions
- Front mudguards must be fitted
- Tail shaft loops must be fitted
- Seats must be securely fastened
- Seat belts must be mounted securely
- Wheel nuts must be fitted to all studs, with no wheel trims to be fitted
- All wheel weights must be either removed from the drive wheels or securely taped

RULES OF COMPETITION

- The intention is to provide as much smoke as possible, without hesitation, in the allocated time limit of 60 seconds
- Headlights must be on
- Any Driver failing to keep within the defined area will be automatically disqualified
- No static burnouts permitted as vehicle must keep moving
 - Long static burnouts will result in a loss of points
- If a tyre or engine blows vehicle is to stop immediately
- Burnouts on pit roads or any other area (other than the designated burnout area) will result in the Driver and vehicle removed from Adelaide Motorsport Park Complex and banned from competing in future events
 - The cost of any damage will be charged to the Driver
- Drivers must not consume alcohol for a minimum of 12 hours prior to or during the event
- No alcohol or glass is to be brought into the Adelaide Motorsport Park Complex
- Drivers must follow the requests of Officials

4 Cylinder – top 3 to compete

6 Cylinder – top 5 to compete

V8 – top 5 to compete

- After Class Finals, break of 15 minutes
