

Adelaide Motorsport Park

Conditions of Entry

For the safety and comfort of all patrons, staff and guests to Adelaide Motorsport Park the following conditions of entry apply to all attendees and those who are on site. In these conditions 'Adelaide Motorsport Park' means the Adelaide Motorsport speedway Complex and all areas deemed a part of this entertainment venue (areas) 173 Supple Road Waterloo Corner.

Adelaide Motorsport Park may also change, update or edit these conditions of entry at any time or have special conditions of entry to certain events imposed. The entry conditions therefore may change without warning and due notice, however they still apply as per the above areas.

Patrons who do not comply with the Entry Conditions will not be permitted entry. All patrons who have been admitted and fail to comply with the Conditions of Entry whilst at the venue may be removed from the venue without any refund.

Code of Conduct Refusal of Entry

- . Adelaide Motorsport Park, its staff, contractors and agents may refuse entry to Adelaide Motorsport Park to anyone particularly any persons who:
 - . Who is considered by Adelaide Motorsport Park to be disorderly, intoxicated, violent, potentially dangerous or quarrelsome
 - . Not holding or presenting a valid entry pass
- . Carrying items that are prohibited by Adelaide Motorsport Park or have the potential to cause injury or nuisance
- . Who possess, in possession or appear to be in possession of any illegal substances or under the influence or appear to be under the influence of illegal substance.
- . People who do not comply with any event specific entry conditions or dress codes to specific areas of the venue or areas.

Restricted or Prohibited Items

A person may not bring the following items into the Adelaide Motorsport Park venue 173 Supple Road Waterloo Corner

Any item or object, the improper use of which, is reasonably considered by Adelaide Motorsport Park as being able to cause harm, injury, nuisance or offence to any other person attending Adelaide Motorsport Park. Any such item may be confiscated by Adelaide Motorsport Park if subsequently found on that person; and the relevant authorities will be notified if required.

- . No hard plastic or hard material Eskies or any kind (Including Foam Eskies)
- . No Glass is permitted within the ground or any area of Adelaide Motorsport Park, 173
Supple Road Waterloo Corner
- . Any form of incendiary device or lighting (Flares, Firework and Laser pointers)
- . Weapons, guns & knives (or any other object that could be used as a weapon*)
- . Oversized signs, flags or banners that are considered by Adelaide Motorsport Park as
capable of causing a nuisance or harm;
- . Loud hailers, megaphones, and musical instruments of any nature (including vuvuzelas,
horns, whistles and drums);
- . Specific conditions may apply for some events regarding the entry of musical instruments
(see event details for more information).
- . * No item that has been made or is considered illegal by the South Australian Police
(SAPOL) or the Australian Federal Police (AFP) to have at a venue or within a public space
for safety reasons and concerns.

Adelaide Motorsport Park reserves the right to Management reserves the right to inspect
and/or search all bags and carrying or holding devices brought into or out of the venue. This
include all vehicles being brought into and out of the venue.

Adelaide Motorsport Park is not responsible for, and may not be held liable by any person,
for loss, theft or damage to any such restricted or prohibited items left by that person in or
around Adelaide Motorsport Park.

Photography and Videography

The taking or recording of Videography and Photography is permitted within Adelaide
Motorsport Park on personal devices for the purpose of personal usage. Any live streaming
or what is deemed live streaming by Adelaide Motorsport Park is not permitted unless prior
signed approval has been gained by Adelaide Motorsport Park and is able to be proven when
asked.

All photographed and videoed items, events and content taken within Adelaide Motorsport
Park is deemed the property of Adelaide Motorsport Park and therefore contains no right to
publish for any commercial or financial gain or usage from it without prior consent from
Adelaide Motorsport Park which must be presented and justified when asked.

General Conditions

Patrons are admitted entry to Adelaide Motorsport Park at their own risk

Some of the sports and racing events are dangerous, Patrons viewing events at Adelaide
Motorsport Park do so at their own risk.

Whilst within Adelaide Motorsport Property patrons are subject to all rules and conditions laid out within this document. They must also abide by the rules and notices that are placed within the venue and follow any instructions written on them.

All patrons must follow the safety directions and stewards requests regarding safety whilst within the venue for safety reasons.

Any areas where entry is not permitted or permitted by certain people or ticket holders all other patrons must respect and acknowledge this area is not for public access and not enter.

Patrons who cause a disturbance, are offensive, discriminatory, display anti-social behaviour, use foul or abusive language, make racial or threatening remarks or gestures, commit indecent exposure or refuse to comply with reasonable requests made by Adelaide Motorsport Park may be evicted.

Patrons may be filmed, recorded or photographed by official broadcasters or photographers and these images or recordings may be used without the consent of, or payment or provision of other compensation to, patrons for all manner of official broadcast or promotional purposes.

Patrons bringing personal items into Adelaide Motorsport Park do so at their own risk. Adelaide Motorsport Park may not be held responsible for any damage, loss or theft of a patron's personal property.

Patrons must not sell any goods or services or give away political, religious, advertising or promotional materials without the prior written consent of Adelaide Motorsport Park and that they can prove or present evidence of.

Patrons may not conduct public surveys or opinion polls or solicit money, donations or subscriptions from members of the public, without the prior written consent of Adelaide Motorsport Park and that they can prove or present evidence of.

Littering is prohibited - patrons are requested to use waste receptacles located around and within Adelaide Motorsport Park

Any person found mistreating, tampering, defacing or damaging any part of Adelaide Motorsport Park or the surrounds will be evicted from Adelaide Motorsport Park and may face prosecution.

Patrons are requested to respect the surrounding area of Adelaide Motorsport Park and the neighbouring private homes, businesses and institutions by acting in an appropriate manner, not littering and not making excessive noise when exiting or entering Adelaide Motorsport Park or associated car parks.

Any articles placed at the entrance to the admission gates to Adelaide Motorsport Park must not be left unattended. Adelaide Motorsport Park accepts no responsibility for personal articles and reserves the right to remove any such articles.

Adelaide Motorsport Park reserves the right to close the venue, Adelaide Motorsport Park gates regardless of whether or not all ticket holders entitled to admission have gained admission to Adelaide Motorsport Park, if in the opinion of Adelaide Motorsport Park, the admission of further persons to Adelaide Motorsport Park would or might endanger the safety of those persons who seek admission or have already been admitted.

Adelaide Motorsport Park may replace or vary these Conditions of Entry at any time and without notice.

Liquor and Alcohol

Adelaide Motorsport Park is a licensed premise and operates under a strict policy of conduct around alcohol and Adelaide Motorsport Park operates within its duties as a venue and within all state laws.

Adelaide Motorsport Park has a no tolerance policy for any alcohol being brought into the venue after being bought externally and for safety reasons reserves the right to confiscate or withhold any alcohol.

Patrons are reminded when entering Adelaide Motorsport Park that:

It is an offence for a minor to purchase and/or consume liquor;

It is an offence to purchase liquor for, or supply liquor to, a minor; and

A person supplying liquor to a minor will be reported to police and penalties apply under the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997 (SA)*.
